### COMMUNITY:

Concord Academy, with 125 churches represented in its student population, is located in Concord, North Carolina. Concord is a thriving city of over 94,000 residents within minutes of Charlotte. It is the home of CMC Northeast Medical Center, Charlotte Motor Speedway, and Concord Mills Mall.

### SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Concord Academy was founded in 1976 and has an enrollment of 800+ students with 339 enrolled in the elementary school (K4-4th). The school is one of the many ministries of Multiply Church and shares the same facilities.

Concord Academy is fully accredited by the Association of Christian Teachers and Schools (ACTS) and Cognia: formerly AdvancED Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS).

### CURRICULUM:

Concord Academy Elementary uses primarily the Bob Jones, Purposeful Design and Saxon curricula. There is an emphasis on the mastery of academic fundamentals and biblical integration: Reading (phonics), Language, Grammar, Science, Mathematics, History and Bible. Concord Academy employs Purposeful Design Science and Bible 1st & 2nd. Saxon Math is taught K5-4th grades. Bob Jones Heritage Studies/Social Studies/Spelling is taught in grades 1st-4th. Bob Jones Science 3rd & 4th. Concord Academy's students regularly score above state and national averages in standardized achievement tests. A variety of other materials are used to supplement as needed, especially in the areas of critical thinking, writing, and test preparation.

### CLASS SIZE:

The elementary school teacher ratio to children averages K4 1:16; K5-4th 1:18.

### MISSION STATEMENT:

It is the mission of Concord Academy to guide our students in achieving academic excellence in a Christian environment while declaring God's power to the next generation...one student at a time.

### FACULTY:

The faculty members meet or exceed the minimum requirements for certification by ACTS. The elementary school faculty consists of two administrators, 21 teachers, 3 teacher assistants, 5 enrichment teachers and 2 resource teachers.
