SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Concord Academy was founded in 1976 and has an enrollment of 800+ students with 217 enrolled in the Middle School. The school is one of the many ministries of Multiply Church and shares the same facilities.

Concord Academy is fully accredited by the Association of Christian Teachers and Schools (ACTS) and Cognia: formerly AdvancED Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS).

CURRICULUM:

The Middle School curriculum is designed to be a well-balanced college preparatory curriculum. The publishers include: Saxon, Bob Jones University Press, Positive Action for Christ, Purposeful Design, Apologia and Trajectory. Concord Academy students regularly score above state and national averages on standardized achievement tests.

CLASS SIZE:

The Middle School teacher ratio to children averages 1:18.
